Nomination

- We kindly remind you to select your students according to the field of studies and number of spots in the agreement.
- Students doing a research project/final thesis in the frame of our SEMP agreement need to be nominated within the deadlines.
- Exchange students who were nominated initially for one semester and wish to extend their exchange need to be nominated again.
- NEW: the nomination and application deadline for exchanges in the Spring semester is now October 15th.
- Please provide your nominated students with our fact sheet.

Academic

- NEW: Please note that some courses are not open to exchange students. The list of restricted course can be found here.
- Students nominated in architecture need to be aware that the choice of studios and teaching units (UE) cannot be guaranteed. Specific information will be provided by the section in due time.

Scholarships

The "Swiss-European Mobility Programme" (SEMP) will continue in 2019-20. The Swiss Government will grant the SEMP scholarships to incoming exchange students who are nominated in the frame of the SEMP programme. According to the country of your home university the grants are as follows:

- **380** CHF per month for students from countries : DK, FI, IS, IE, LI, LU, NO, SE, UK

- **440** CHF per month for students from countries : AT, BE, BG, CY, CZ, DE, EE, EL, ES, FR, HR, HU, IT, LT, LV, MK, MT, NL, PL, PT, RO, SI, SK, TR

We will pay scholarships equivalent to 5 months for 1 semester, and 10 months for one academic year. Students who will do a research project/final thesis in a lab and who have been nominated through our SEMP agreement within the deadlines will be granted a scholarship of maximum 5 months.

Accommodation

As it is very difficult for students to find accommodation in Lausanne, we recommend that they start their search as soon as they have been nominated by you by using all the options on our <u>website</u>.
